With its own fleet of 4,600 loading units and a network of 49 offices in 16 countries, the company achieved a turnover of €395 million in 2009. ECC offers its clients two forms of transport capacity: road transport and intermodal transport. To accomplish this, ECC has its own standardised fleet of loading units that are used Europe-wide. The ECC fleet consists of 4,500 units: 3,000 'Mega' and other specialist trailers and about 1,500 intermodal units ranging from 20-ft coil carriers to 13.6-metre swap bodies. Last but not least, our customers benefit from lower costs per m³ by using the Mega trailer (100 m³) and the lower costs per tonne with the intermodal units: 'The right transport unit for any load'

The Ewals Cargo Care 'Store' concept extends beyond handling and storage. The scope of 'Store' includes a wide range of value-added services throughout the supply chain. All processes are measured to improve material flow and minimise costs, enabling Ewals to continuously review and adjust processes as demand dictates. This allows our customers to concentrate on their core business. Ewals Cargo Care has warehousing and cross-dock facilities throughout Europe, totalling 300,000m². 'Store' services provide dedicated warehousing, common user warehouses, value-added services, in-house services and supply chain synergies.



Manage.

The Manage concept places the focus on the customer by making use of the wider transport market. The focus here lies on Ewals Cargo Care's extensive knowledge in freight management. The customer benefits from the fact that ECC acts as of the designated contact for all required transport modes and destinations. With its own extensive network of transport partners, ECC can respond flexibly to capacity peaks, special transport requirements and geographic shifts in the client's supply chain. ECC offers two different solutions to customers wanting to contract out the management of all or part of their transport and/or warehousing activities: Freight Management and Freight Forwarding.
